### **PAYMENT TIMING AND PROCESS**

- Customer must sign up at [COUPONPORTAL.AFSI.COM](http://COUPONPORTAL.AFSI.COM) and provide tax information (W 9) prior to submission.
- To submit your claim, go to [COUPONPORTAL.AFSI.COM](http://COUPONPORTAL.AFSI.COM) **COUPON CODE 5850980**. Enter for purchases between 1/1/19 and 1/31/19.
- Upload Proof of purchase from a qualified Foodservice Distributor **AND** copy of cases purchased in the coupon portal (Can also mail in proof of performance).
- Payments mailed directly to operator 6-8 weeks after claim submission
- For submission assistance, contact 1-800-529-9624
- Maximum payout : \$5,000
- Only one submission per operator location.
- Must submit rebate request by February 28, 2019

### **IRS REQUIREMENT ON COUPON SIGNUP**

- We are required by the IRS to report your rebate if it exceeds \$600 in a calendar year.
- To enable that reporting, have this information available to complete sign up.
  - Federal Tax ID
  - Current W-9
- School District Name and Address EXACTLY as registered with the IRS.
